

## SCHEDULE 1

### REQUIREMENTS FOR UNITS

(Section 10)

#### 1. Nucleus units

A unit on which nucleus plants are cultivated shall comply with the following requirements:

- 1.1 The unit shall be covered by an insect-proof greenhouse.
- 1.2 The plants on the unit shall be established in containers in soil that is free of vectors of grapevine fanleaf.
- 1.3 The floor area of the greenhouse shall be covered in such a way that the roots of plants kept in containers thereon cannot permeate to the soil on which the greenhouse is erected.
- 1.4 Such greenhouse shall by means of an isolation area of at least two metres wide be isolated from any other vineyard and soil other than virgin soil.
- 1.5 No plants of any kind shall occur in such isolation area unless the authority has consented thereto in writing.
- 1.6 Irrigation water used in such unit shall -
  - 1.6.1 not be contaminated by drainage or run-off water from any other vineyard; and
  - 1.6.2 be free of any vectors of all known harmful vine viral diseases as well as vectors of phytoplasmas.

#### 2. Foundation plant units

A unit on which foundation plants are cultivated shall comply with the following requirements:

- 2.1 .....

- 2.2 The plants on the unit shall -

- 2.2.1 be established in virgin soil that is free of vectors of grapevine fanleaf; or
- 2.2.2 in the case of plants in containers, be established in soil that is free of vectors of grapevine fanleaf.
- 2.3 .....

- 2.4 The unit shall by means of an isolation area be isolated from any other vineyard and soil other than virgin soil.
- 2.5 Such isolation area shall -
  - 2.5.1 in the case of a unit established in a greenhouse, be at least one metre wide; and
  - 2.5.2 otherwise be at least three metres wide.

- 2.6 No plants of any kind shall occur within three metres of the unit unless the authority has consented thereto in writing.

- 2.7 Irrigation water used in such unit shall be free of any vectors of grapevine fanleaf.

### 3. **Foundation nursery units**

A unit on which foundation nursery plants are cultivated shall comply with the following requirements:

- 3.1 The soil of the unit shall -
  - 3.1.1 be virgin soil unless foundation nursery plants have previously been cultivated thereon; and
  - 3.1.2 be free of any vectors of grapevine fanleaf.
- 3.2 If a unit is a greenhouse, the floor area of the greenhouse shall be covered in such a way that the roots of plants kept in containers thereon cannot permeate to the soil on which the greenhouse was erected.
- 3.3 .....

- 3.4 The unit shall by means of an isolation area be isolated from any other vineyard and soil other than virgin soil.

3.5 Such isolation area shall -

3.5.1 in the case of a unit established in a greenhouse, be at least one metre wide; and

3.5.2 otherwise be at least three metres wide.

3.6 No plants of any kind shall occur within three metres of the unit unless the authority has consented thereto in writing.

3.7 Irrigation water used in such unit shall be free of any vectors of fanleaf virus.

4. **Mother units**

A unit in which mother plants are cultivated shall comply with the following requirements:

4.2 The soil of the unit must be free from vectors of grapevine fanleaf

4.4 The unit shall be isolated from any other vineyard by means of an isolation area.

4.5 Such isolation area shall –

4.5.1 be free of any plants of any nature; and

4.5.2 be at least three metres wide.

5. **Nursery units**

A unit in which nursery plants are cultivated shall comply with the following requirements:

5.1 The plants on the unit shall be established in soil that is free of vectors of grapevine fanleaf.

- 5.2 If a unit is a greenhouse, the floor area of the greenhouse shall be covered in such a way that the roots of plants kept in containers thereon cannot permeate to the soil on which the greenhouse is erected.

- 5.4 The unit shall by means of an isolation area be isolated from any other vineyard.
- 5.5 Such isolation area shall -
- 5.5.1 if the other vineyard concerned consists of rooted plants of a species of the genus *Vitis* be at least three metres wide; and
- 5.5.2 if the other vineyard concerned consists of unrooted plants of a species of the genus *Vitis*, be at least 800mm wide.
